



2024-2025 SAP LIAISON ANNUAL REPORTING





The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services and Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs collaborate to provide the SAP Liaison Annual Reporting System to collect data from agencies who provide county-funded SAP liaison services. As representatives of the county drug and alcohol (D&A) and mental health (MH) systems, professionally trained liaisons provide support to school SAP teams and families through screenings/assessments and other services for drug and alcohol and/or mental health related concerns. Below is an overview of the data reported by 97 liaison providers and agencies for the 2024/25 school year.








