FAQ Corner

"Did You Forget Something? - Don't forget to submit!"

Annual PDE4092 data submission is due by June 30th each year – is your team ready to submit data on all the referrals received by your SAP team this year? Check that the correct staff have a login and access so you're ready for data entry. Start early, use the system to check for errors, and don't forget to release the data to the state by June 30th! The following are excerpts from the <u>SAP Frequently</u> <u>Asked Questions and Best Practice Document</u>.

21. What data is required to be submitted by SAP teams? Each school entity must submit non- identified referral data through the SAP online reporting system. The specific data points are found on the PDE 4092 Reporting Form. The PDE 4092 data is reported via the Pennsylvania Safe Schools Online Application and is due annually no later than June 30. Teams are encouraged to enter data throughout the school year. The system is available to input data early in the school year through the end of the school year, at which time teams must select the button to "release" the data to PDE.

Data is entered on the Safe Schools website located here: <u>www.safeschools.pa.gov</u>. Don't forget to submit and release your data to the state. Contact your <u>PNSAS SAP Regional Coordinator</u> for assistance.

"Liaisons Report Data Too!"

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SAP Liaison Annual Reporting is due by July 31st. Be sure to contact your regional coordinator with any questions or assistance with reporting data. Check that the correct staff have a login and access so you're ready for data entry. Data should be submitted and approved by county agencies by July 31st. Liaison data reporting website is: <u>www.pnsas-sapliaisonreport.org</u>. The excerpts below are from the <u>Liaison Frequently Asked Questions</u>.

33. Does data from the SAP Liaison Annual Report need to be completed for students from the elementary schools? Yes, all liaison screenings and assessments for all ages should be included in the annual report.
