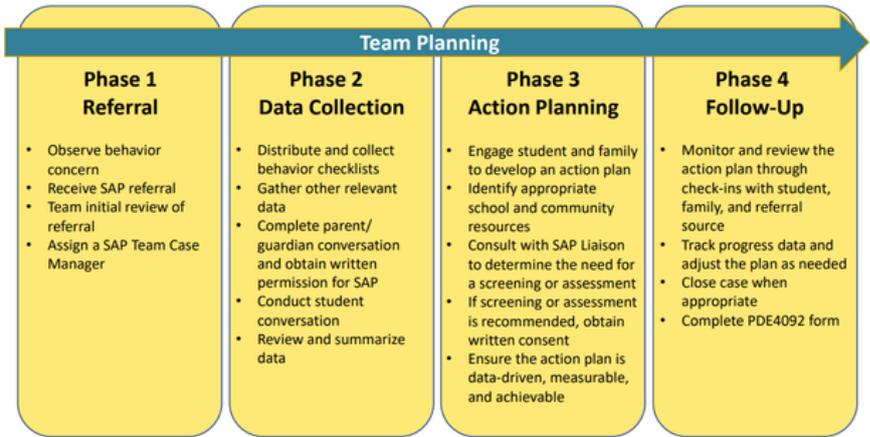
Navigating the Teams Page

This year's SAP articles will focus on the resources available on the PA Network for Student Assistance Services (PNSAS) website. PNSAS regularly updates documents and adds additional resources to the site. The SAP Connection articles will review available resources each month to assist SAP teams and other stakeholders.

The Teams page includes helpful documents such as the **"SAP Best Practices by Phase."**

Not sure which resources or documents you need? The **PNSAS SAP Resource List** is a great place to start. It includes links to our most up to date documents. The resource list is broken down into four topics. The first, General SAP in PA, starts at the very core of the SAP process and links documents like "What is SAP?" and "Laws Pertaining to SAP" which can help your team understand their responsibilities.

The second topic in the resource list is the Best Practice and Guidance Documents which includes all of the best practice documents for teams and liaisons. It also has considerations for schools and providers concerning school-based outpatient treatment.

The third topic contains links to all of the sample forms your team may need. Don't have an agenda for your team meetings? Need to know what a behavior checklist might look like? Let us help!

The last topic on the resource list is reporting and it provides links to the PDE 4092 for schools and the SAP Liaison Annual Report (SLAR) . PNSAS is dedicated to helping your team be successful. Your Regional Coordinator is available to answer questions and support your team.

As a reminder, each school building is asked to submit anonymous student referral data using the SAP 4092 Form through the [Commonwealth SAP On-Line Reporting System](#) by June 30, 2026. The system is already open, so you can begin entering data as you wrap up the school year. You can even start a SAP form with just a case number and add details later.

All webinars will be held from 10:00-11:00am on the following dates with the listed topics:

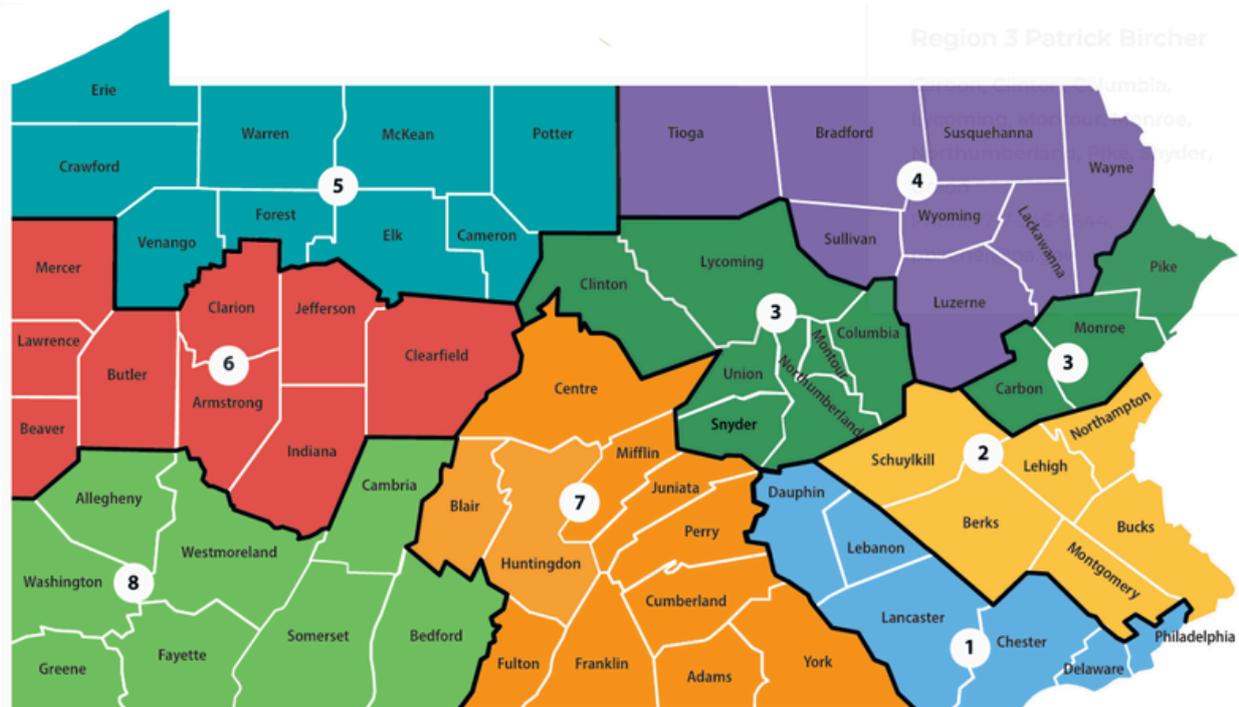
